TOWN HALL Q&A

Question: What is Parish Suppression? **Answer:**

- This is a decree issued by the bishop that ceases a parish's existence.
- If one parish or possibly more than one parish is suppressed, then another parish is notably altered. A new parish may be erected in the process of merging parishes.
- The bishop may wish to celebrate a "Closing Mass" at the parish shortly before its suppression.
